ACTION	COST
1. Employment of support staff to develop and deliver targeted academic, social and emotional support programs across the school – BASES TEACHER	\$100 000
2. Employment of support staff to enhance explicit improvement in literacy and numeracy – targeted teacher aide time	\$ 48 183
3. Professional learning time for teachers to plan and moderate curriculum to improve teaching and learning focus	\$ 40 000
4. Professional learning time and resources to support intervention in targeted areas – reading, writing, number	\$ 20 000
5. Investment in programs and professional development to support learning and wellbeing	\$ 40 000
