


Initiative	Strategies and Evidence Base
1. Improve student achievement in reading and writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Utilise intervention strategies to support students identified below and above year level expectations • Provide additional support to enhance classroom guided reading and writing • Focused vocabulary development across all year levels
2. Social and emotional wellbeing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continued PD for teachers to support students with identified needs • Support for families within and beyond the school • Provision of teacher support to assist individuals, groups and cohorts
3. Indigenous perspectives in the curriculum	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Utilisation of newly developed school Indigenous curriculum program within teacher planning including resource development • Local Indigenous Elder invited to support implementation and provide additional PD for teachers • Increased link between Indigenous Playgroup and school curriculum
