

School Uniform Rationale

At Burnside State School, we focus on building a safe, supportive, learning environment in all aspects of school life. A safe and supportive learning environment is further enhanced by an acceptable dress code that promotes:

- An effective teaching and learning environment by eliminating the distraction of competition in dress and fashion at school
- A safe environment for learning by enabling ready identification of students and not students at school
- Community values, expectations and perceptions of the school; and
- Mutual respect among students through minimising visible evidence of economic, class or social differences.

Students are required to wear their full uniform including fully enclosed black shoes, plain visible ankle socks and a full brim school hat each school day and for all formal occasions such as excursions, awards ceremonies, school photos, and other school related public functions.

The Burnside State School Student Dress Code is endorsed by the Parents and Citizens' Association and is fully explained to parents / carers as part of the enrolment agreement at Burnside State School. The Student Dress Code reflects community standards and is consistent with occupational health and safety, and anti-discrimination legislation.

SCHOOL SHIRT

Burnside State School polo shirt. Year 6 students may wear their Year 6 Senior shirt for their final year in primary school.



SCHOOL SHORT

Burnside State School shorts or plain navy blue shorts of a suitable length. There is an option of wearing a Burnside State School Skort which is a skirt/short combination.

SHOES



Predominantly black joggers/trainers, younger students may prefer the Velcro strap fastener to the lace up variety. Black leather shoes may be worn too. Covered, supportive shoes are recommended at all times.

SOCKS

Plain, white, dark (blue or black) short socks.

WINTER UNIFORM

During June to September, plain navy tights may be worn under school shorts. Navy tracksuit pants may be worn over or instead of school shorts.

Plain navy blue jackets and jumpers can be worn in winter. If the jumper / jacket has a hoodie, the hoodie is not to be worn over the student's head during the school day.

Jumpers and hoodies worn at school, must not have a logo or emblem, and are to be plain navy only.

HAT

A navy blue bucket hat or an acceptable navy blue wide brimmed hat. Please remember we are a Sun Smart school and abide by these principles. Students are strongly encouraged to wear their hats to and from school.

HAIR

Long hair is to be tied back with appropriate hair ties. Any ornamental hair accessories are to be in school colours- navy, gold, green or in plain colours - black or white.



JEWELLERY

Students may wear a watch, a school badge and a discreet necklace, should it be necessary. The necklace must not be visible and should remain inside the student's shirt at all times. Ornamental necklaces are not permitted. Students may wear one pair of either small sleepers or studs. Medi-Alert necklaces and bracelets are the exception to this rule. Note: No visible body/facial piercings e.g. nose, brow, lip studs or rings.

Facial piercings must be removed for school, covered with protective tape, or filled with a retainer available from piercing suppliers.

MAKE-UP

The wearing of make up in any form is not permitted.
